

CRITERIA AND RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

1. Merchandise and services displayed and sold should not present a hazard to the public. Items such as sparklers, fireworks, knives, firearms, canned string, fart sprays, drug paraphernalia, etc. will not be permitted.
2. The Festival Committee reserves the right to limit the number of vendors selling any type of merchandise and to exclude any display or merchandise for any reason.
3. You will receive written verification that your booth has been accepted into the show. If you do not receive written verification then your booth has not been accepted into the show and your fee will be refunded.
4. Booths accepted for participation must fit within the space purchased. This includes tie downs, trailer tongues, pop-up windows, etc. Encroachment on adjacent spaces is not permitted.
5. Only items which have been listed on the application and approved by the Festival Committee will be allowed for sale or display at your booth. Food items are allowed for sale only in designated areas.
6. Subletting a booth or any part of a booth to any other person or organization not listed on the application is strictly prohibited and could result in expulsion.
7. Vendors are responsible for collecting and remitting a 6% sales tax to the State of Florida. Non-profit organizations must include their tax exemption number issued by the State of Florida on their application.
8. If electricity is needed it must be noted on the application and fee paid. Vendors must furnish a 75' heavy duty, all-weather extension cord and must be sure the circuits are not overloaded. Trucks, campers, or vans are not allowed to plug into the electricity during festival operating hours.
9. Vendors are permitted to sell within their booth space and are not allowed to sell merchandise outside their assigned area (i.e. walking through the crowd) unless preapproved by the committee.
10. No advertisements or signs for vendors are permitted outside the designated booth space. Use of sound amplification devices and audio equipment (bullhorns, P.A. systems) is strictly prohibited within the booth areas.
11. Parking behind booths is very limited. Vendors will be issued one parking pass per booth space which will allow them to park ONE vehicle behind their booth only if space allows.
12. The deadline for setting up booths is 7:00 AM on Saturday, (day of the show). Hours of operation are 8:00 am till 4:00 pm on the day of the show.
13. No pets or firearms are allowed.
14. All food vendors will conduct their business in compliance with the Florida Administrative Code, Chapter 10-D-13, as well as, any and all other state or federal laws regarding the preparation, distribution, and/or sale of food or beverages.
